Deadline: Friday, April 30, 2021

These scholarships will be awarded to female, high school seniors (graduating 2021), intending to enroll at an ABET accredited university for the upcoming school year and majoring in an engineering, computing, or engineering technology program. The students must be currently enrolled in high school in one of the following Georgia or South Carolina counties: Beaufort, Bryan, Chatham, Effingham, Jasper, Liberty, Long or McIntosh.
